### **Meeting Minutes**

#### **1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL.**

- a. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Mullen. PFC Commissioners present: Jerry Mullen, Jim McKay, Lisa Becher, Angela Wilcox, and Vince Wagner. Staff Members present: Interim Police Chief Brian Redman.

#### **2. PUBLIC APPEARANCES.**

- a. This is an opportunity for members of the public to address the Police and Fire Commission. Members of the public who wish to address the Commission should fill out a public comment form and turn into the meeting chairperson. #### **3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES.**

- a. Motion to approve the minutes of the September 2, 2025 meeting. Discussion and action regarding the minutes of the meeting. Call for changes or corrections. Hearing none, President Mullen called for a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Motion by Commissioner McKay and seconded by Commissioner Wilcox. Motion passed on a unanimous vote.

#### **4. BUSINESS.**

- a. Discussion and action regarding the probationary period for Sergeant Bruce Grady. After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Wagner and seconded by Commissioner McKay that Sergeant Grady's probationary period by six (6) months, starting August 10, 2025. Motion passed on a unanimous vote.

#### **5. CLOSED SESSION**

- a. Discussion and action to convene into Closed Session in accordance with Wis. Stats. 19.85(1)(c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has

jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, more specifically to interview finalists for Police Officer position with the Police Department.

Roll call vote: Jerry Mullen, Jim McKay, Lisa Becher, Angela Wilcox, and Vince Wagner voting yes.

#### **7. ACTION ON ITEMS DISCUSSED IN CLOSED SESSION.**

- a. Discussion and action to approve establishing an eligibility list for the Police Officer position within the Police Department. A motion was made by Commissioner McKay and seconded by Commissioner Becher to establish an eligibility list for Police Officer. The list will be effective from September 22, 2025 to March 22, 2026. Motion passed on a unanimous vote. President Mullen will prepare a letter for Interim Chief Redman listing the eligible candidate.

#### **9. ADJOURNMENT.**

- a. A motion to adjourn was made by President Mullen and seconded by Commissioner McKay. Motion passed on a unanimous vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:51 p.m.
