1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL.

- a. Meeting called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Commissioner Wilcox.

PFC Commissioners present: Angela Wilcox, Dustin Boyd, and Lisa Becher.

PFC Commissioner excused: Jim McKay and Tristan Eagon.

Staff Members present: Police Chief Brian Redman, HR Generalist Andrea Anderson, Fire & Rescue Captain James Reiter, and Fire & Rescue Chief Chris Dennis.

Discussion and action regarding the minutes of the meeting. Call for changes or corrections. Hearing none, Commissioner Wilcox called for a motion to accept the minutes as presented. A motion was made by Commissioner Becher and seconded by Commissioner Boyd. Motion passed on a unanimous vote.

4. BUSINESS.

- a. Discussion and action for scheduling a meeting for Fire & Rescue interviews for the positions of EMT/Firefighter, AEMT/Firefighter, and Firefighter/Paramedic.

After discussion regarding the number of potential candidates (12-14) that Chief Dennis would like to send for PFC interviews, the Commission determined that the interview process would be broken up over multiple nights with up to 4 or so interviews per night with the interview dates yet to be determined.

- b. Discussion and action on the Police Chief's recommendation on the appointments of Officer Kevin Schneider, Officer Jacob Towns, and Officer Blake Chambers upon the successful completion of the probationary periods.

The motion to approve the recommendation of the 3 officers was made by Commissioner Boyd and seconded by Commissioner Becher. The motion passed on a unanimous vote. Andrea Anderson will draft letters for Commissioner Wilcox's signature to confirm the Officers' appointments.
