Meeting Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL.

- a. Meeting called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Commissioner Wagner.

PFC Commissioners present: Jim McKay, Angela Wilcox and Vince Wagner.

PFC Commissioner excused: Lisa Becher.

Staff Members present: Police Chief Brian Redman and Fire & Rescue Chief Chris Dennis.

- b. Discussion and action on the Fire Chief's recommendation of the appointment of Admirative Captain Kris Loy upon the successful completion of his probationary period.

The motion to approve Chief Dennis's request to appoint Kris Loy as Administrative Captain of the McFarland Fire and Rescue department effective April 8, 2026, was made by Commissioner Wilcox and seconded by Commissioner McKay. The motion passed on a unanimous vote.

- c. Discussion and action of the Police Chief's request to establish a recruitment process for the vacant Police Officer position.

After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner McKay and seconded by Commissioner Wilcox to approve the recruitment process as outlined by Chief Redman. The posting will only be for lateral transfers from other police departments. The motion passed on a unanimous vote.
