Meeting Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL.

- a. Meeting called to order at 6:01 p.m. by President Mullen. PFC Commissioners present: Jerry Mullen, Jim McKay and Angela Wilcox. PFC Commissioners excused: Vince Wagner. Staff Members present: Police Chief Aaron Chapin.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES.

- a. Motion to approve the minutes of the August 22, 2024, meeting. Discussion and action regarding minutes of the meeting. Call for changes or corrections. Hearing none, President Jerry Mullen called for a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Motion by Commissioner McKay and seconded by President Mullen. Motion passed on a unanimous vote.

4. CLOSED SESSION.

- a. Discussion and action to convene into Closed Session in accordance with Wis. - a. The posting for the Police Officer position is listed for 60 days on Wilenet. Chief Chapin has requested that the Police and Fire Commission reconvene during the week of September 16, 2024 to conduct additional interviews. There are currently five applicants under review. Panel interviews consisting of Chief Chapin, Sergeant Jacobsen, a representative from Human Resources and at least one rank and file police officer are scheduled for Friday, September 13, 2024. PFC interviews will be conducted of the applicants who are approved by the panel to advance in the hiring process.
